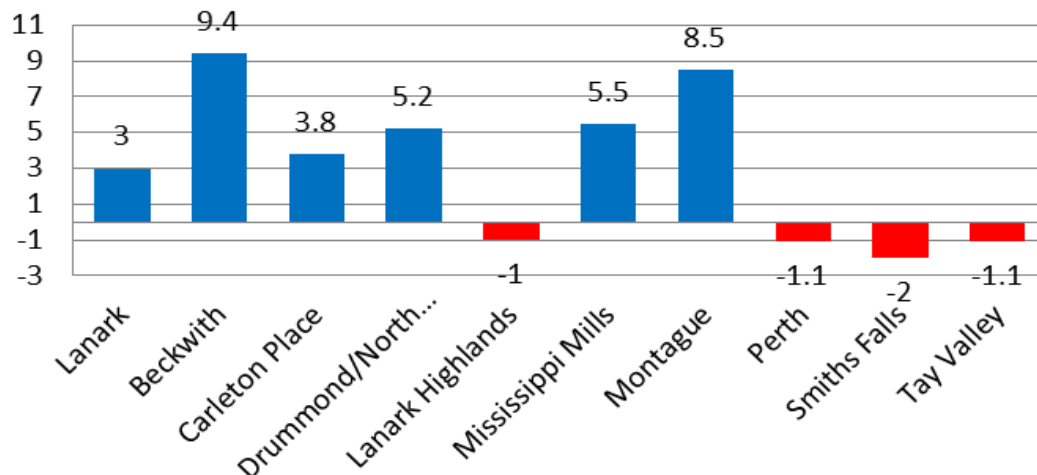

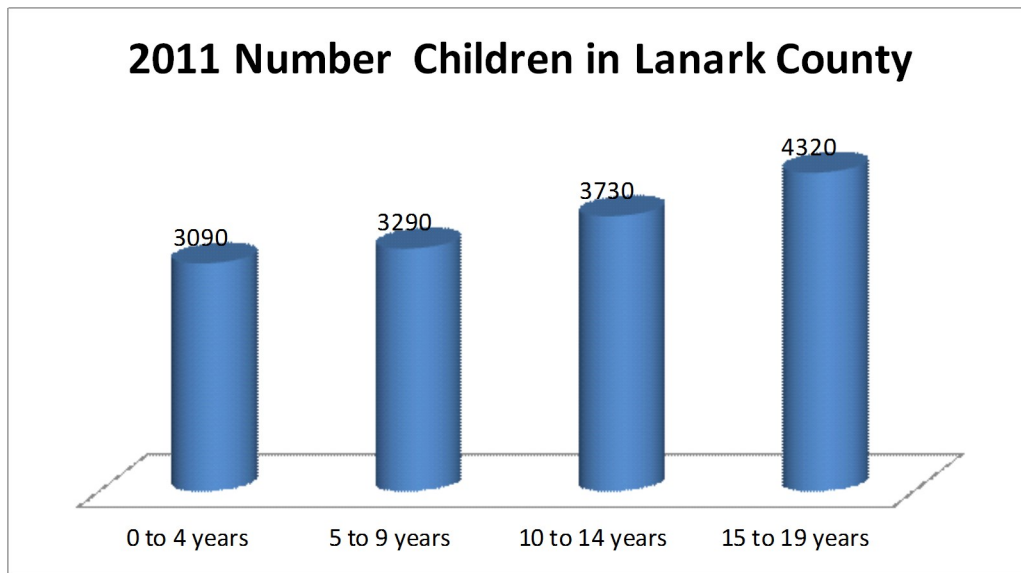

Population Change 2006 to 2011 Census

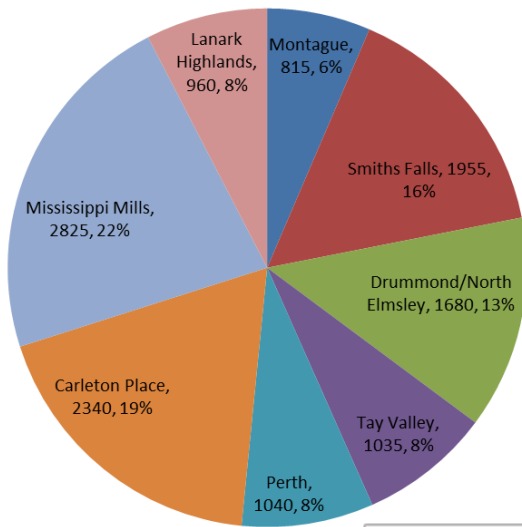

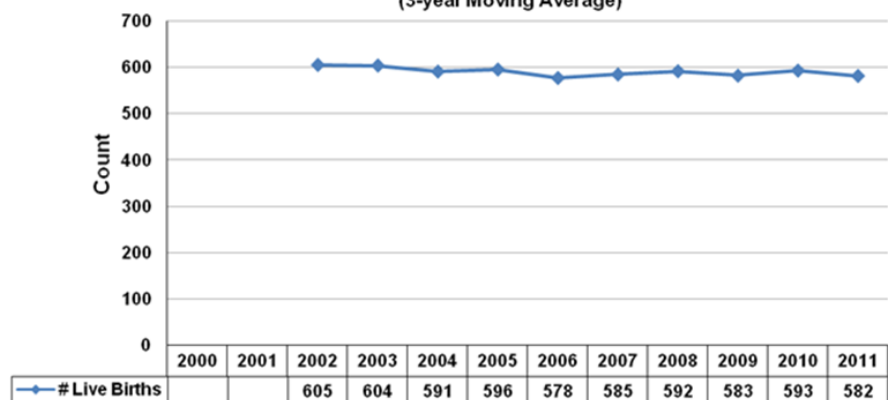
Population of Children¹

Family Structure¹

Number of Families: Of all census families in private households in Lanark County 83.06% (16445) have children 24 and younger living at home. The areas with the largest number of children 24 and younger are Mississippi Mills (16%), Carleton Place(13%) and Smiths Falls (11%).

Lone Parent Families: In Lanark County there are 2730 lone parent families, 13.79% of our families are lone parent families. The areas with the largest number of lone parent families are Smiths Falls (21.79%), and Carleton Place (20.33%).

Participants may come in as often as needed and receive a top up).

Food Bank Facts

- An average of 35% of the people who use a food bank in Ontario are children (0-18 years old)
- Though Ontario saw a 7.1% decline in food bank use in 2013, rural food banks are still experiencing increases .
- The Good Food Bank saw an increase of 8% in 2013.

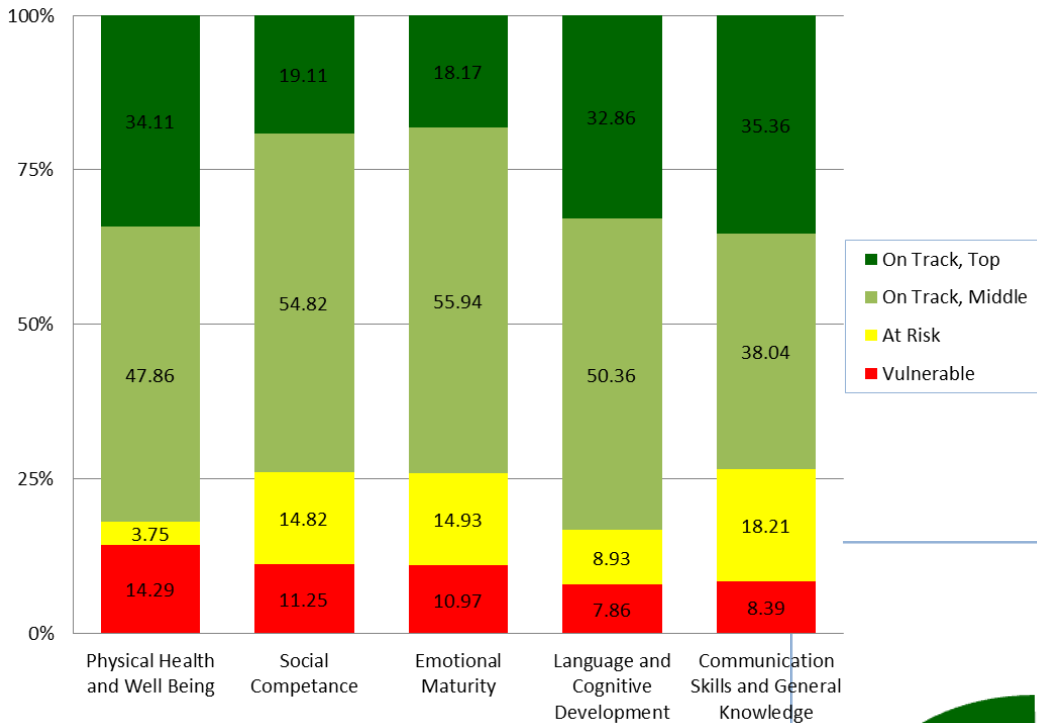

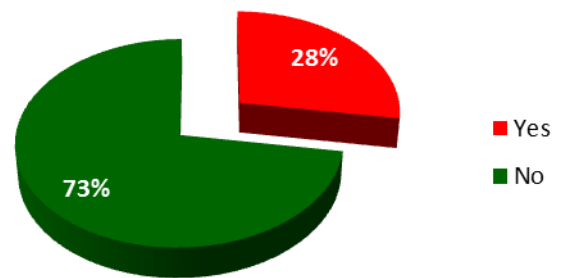
