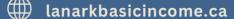

# WHAT IS BASIC INCOME

Basic Income is money distributed to eligible people, regularly, reliably, and without work requirement, and which, absent other income, should meet basic human needs.

It is an income floor to help eliminate the risk of falling into poverty and to provide greater stability as people navigate transitions and challenging times.

## WE ARE ALL VULNERABLE

In times of uncertainty and financial stress, a basic income improves stability and flexibility. Canada already has basic income programs like the Canada Child Benefit for families with children under 18, and the **Guaranteed Income Supplement** for seniors. A Basic Income Guarantee for working-age adults would fill the gap and complete a Canada where people have the financial security they need to live with dignity, and contribute to society in their own way.
